We will also be greeting and encouraging the staff with **letters of appreciation** and an **appreciation dinner**.

We would like to give **hand written letters** and **cards to the staff**.

We **need** approximately **30 letters**.

We will be serving through a variety of activities and service projects, including:

God Centered

- Attending the New Life Foundation's Bi-annual International Conference, celebrating the work that is doing at the school.
- Participating in worship, devotions, gatherings with students and staff.

Service Projects

- Participating in student outreach service projects to their community.
- Providing a variety construction and maintenance projects to help improve the school facilities.

Medical Personnel and Resources

- Assist local medical personnel to provide a well-care medical clinic for the students and staff.
- Provide sustainable feminine-hygiene kits and education from Days for Girls.
- Provide first aid kits for the classrooms and dormitories and supplies for the medical clinic.

Fun & Education

- Play with students and visit their families in their homes
- Lead teacher/staff educational seminar

Media Recordings

- Record video greetings from each of the sponsored students to their sponsors.
- Obtain video footage for updated videos to share the story and needs of New Life Foundation.

Meetings

 Attend an international board meeting with the school's Board of Directors and directors from other international supporting organizations similar to NLIF.

There will be more opportunities for service and celebration, but these provide an idea of what the team will be doing.

We have several specific **requests** for you over the **next 3 weeks**:

- 1. **Pray** for the team and the service it will be providing.
- 2. If you are a sponsor, **send us a letter or card** with a recent photo of you and your family to your sponsored student.
- 3. Provide **letters of appreciation** to the staff.
- 4. Help us raise \$6,050 to fund

\$3,500 for construction materials. \$1,400 for first aid kits & supplies for the well-care clinic. \$525 for the feminine-hygiene kits. \$625 for the appreciation dinner.
